

Medicare Referral - Information for Families

Medicare Rebates may apply through the 'Better Access to Mental Health Care Initiative' if assessed eligible via a GP, private paediatrician or psychiatrist.

If seeking a referral via your GP, a 'GP Mental Health Treatment Plan must be completed (please book a double appointment).

Referrals are not required for private health rebates or NDIS purposes.

To be eligible to claim the Medicare rebate, we require a valid referral which includes the following details:

- o referral date
- o patient's name, DOB, address
- o reason for referral (e.g. Diagnosis /presenting concern)
- o a copy of the MHTP or statement it has been completed (applicable for GP referrals only)
- o referrer's Medicare provider number and signature
- o request for an initial course of treatment, which for the purposes of the Life Skills program, includes a referral up to **6 individual AND 6 group** allied mental health sessions. (Please note that the program includes 2 individual and 6 group sessions).

Please feel free to share this information at your GP appointment, including the attached optional referral form they can complete.

We will provide a written update following your child's completion of the program to your referrer.

What is the Medicare Rebate and how do I claim this?

The full program fee \$880 is paid up front after confirmation of your child's place following the initial session. This fee includes 9 Clinical Psychology Sessions (2 individual sessions & 6 weekly 90-minute group sessions & parent information video).

The full Medicare rebate is \$471, and applies only for referrals acquired on or prior to the initial appointment date.

The total out of pocket expense is \$409.

Itemised receipts are issued at group session 6 (this includes the first individual appointment and 6 group sessions) and at the follow-up session. You can submit a Medicare online claim using either your Medicare online account through myGov or the Express Plus Medicare mobile app.
